THINGS TO KNOW SPRING AND FALL EVENTS

VEHICLE INFORMATION

- * We still use the 67 lb rule for batteries. Lithium and flooded acid are not acceptable
- * Seat belt and shoulder harness must be mounted close to the neck
- * Seat belt crotch strap must be underneath the body and mounted to a structural member
- * Side support rails must be shoulder high
- * Roll bar/helmet height will be measured from the top of the roll bar to a front structural member
- * Ballast must be securely mounted and not interfere with the driver
- * During the driver change, only the new driver and two pit crew members are allowed in the pit
- * When entering the pit area you are to go to the farthest open bay, an attendant will instruct you when it is safe to enter the track
- * Slow vehicles are to stay to the inside of the track. Should the car fail to complete a lap in sixty seconds the car will be removed from competition
- * When passing another vehicle, You must pass in the DESIGNATED AREA ONLY
- * At the end of the heat, each driver is to pull into the pit area and remain in the vehicle until the car is inspected and driver and ballast weighed. The adviser will be the only person to assist the driver.

EVENT INFORMATION

YOUR TEAM WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IF YOU ARE MISSING ANY OF THE REGISTRATION INFORMATION LISTED ON THE LAST PAGE, (WHAT TO SEND IN). WE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTING ANY FORMS AT THE COMPETITION.

Each team will be restricted to twenty team members plus an adviser for every ten students

INSURANCE LIABILITY RELEASE FORMS are required for each student under the age of eighteen. Students are to complete pages one and two of the **MINOR'S ASSUMPTION and PARENTAL CONSENT FORM** and hand them in at the Lime Rock Gate. You may make as many copies as needed. **CT ELECTRATHON IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACCOUNTABILITY OF STUDENTS AND WILL BE HELD HARMLESS SHOULD AN UNDERAGE STUDENT BE INJURED WITHOUT HAVING THE PROPER DOCUMENTATION.**

To expedite the process when entering the track, please complete the **RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY FORM**, (attached),. This form is to be completed on the day of the event and signed by everyone entering the track.

Medical Liability / Release Forms are **ONLY NEEDED** for the drivers. Both sections need to be completed since one part stays with the folder and the other section is placed in the arm band,

Due to the popularity of the program we have limited each participating school to a maximum of two vehicles,

Once inside the main gate **FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE GATE ATTENDANT** and find a spot behind the yellow tape, get unloaded and wait for the **REGISTRATION TABLE** to call your team. **Only one vehicle and trailer permitted behind the yellow tape per team.**

Each team is required to have ONE volunteer to assist with flagging and communications.

We have been using transponders for the past two competitions with great success, but the problem is teams returning them to the Race Stewart. At our January meeting it was decided that to ensure the return of the transponders we will hold the advisers Driver license until we receive the transponder.

CLASSES

NOVICE CLASS This class is open to first time teams that have just completed their first vehicle. They will remain in this class for a full season

CLASSIC CLASS This class is designed for teams that have prior experience in Electrathon Competition. Vehicles are limited to hand built metal cars and kit cars..

COMPOSITE CLASS Cars that are constructed entirely of composite material, (no frame), will compete in this class. Should the composite vehicle be your first attempt at the Electrathon series your team will participate in this class

Enclosed in the registration Packet is a **Vehicle Inspection Form(PAGE)**. By having this Information in advance, you are giving yourself an advantage of making sure everything will go smoothly, allowing the vehicle inspection process to go more quickly and addressing any potential problems in advance. The inspection form does not need to be returned.

Rules and Regulations

- **Students are not to leave the track area**
- **Each team must have at least one adult responsible for each 10 students.**
- **The inspection team will not tolerate any type of harassment from the team or its leaders. If this happens you will be asked to leave. Inspectors will make every effort to see that your team participates. Safety is their first priority if something is not to regulation, remember that they did not construct the vehicle.**
- **Each team is required to have at least 1 volunteer (if needed) to assist the race officials.**
- **Teams are required to pick up after themselves. Waste receptacles will be placed near the track.**
- **All the persons associated with an Electrathon event are expected to conduct themselves in a cordial manner. Confrontations or arguments will not be tolerated and participants are subject to disqualification.**
- **Once a decision has been rendered concerning a specific issue and your team disagrees, follow the grievance procedure. Don't go to another official and try to reverse the decision.**
- **Should your team vehicle experience trouble on the track, the driver is to pull off the track to a designated work area. No competition car will be allowed back to the team area.**
- **The pit crew is not to cross the track!! The pit crew (Maximum 3 members) may walk along the outside grass section, under the yellow flag, to make repairs. Should the vehicle experience trouble on the inside of the track the pit crew must wait for the yellow flag and for the race steward to allow them to cross the track. The pit crew is to have a maximum of three people.**

REGISTRATION / INSPECTION PROCEDURE

- * Your team name will appear on a white board near the Registration table. Team names are placed on the board as complete packets are received.
- * Your team will be called to the Registration table. Please bring the car, competition batteries, ballast, arm bands, two drivers and helmets. **NO ADDITIONAL PEOPLE INCLUDING THE ADVISER**
- * Drivers will take the flag test and then receive a folder with all inspection materials.
- * Drivers are to **place stickers** on the batteries and place them in the designated area, then proceed to the weigh-in.
- * Only the two drivers are allowed to take the car through the inspection process.
- * Once the car passes inspection, place the class sticker on the car and **RETURN THE FOLDER TO THE REGISTRATION TABLE.**
- * Bring your instructor to the Registration table to receive your transponder, Adviser must forfeit his/her license to receive a transponder.

Should a car fail inspection the adviser will be called and the problem explained. **EVERY EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO HAVE THE CAR PARTICPATE, BUT SAFETY IS OUR TOP PRIORITY**

DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF EVENT(S)

IN CONSIDERATION of my minor child ("the Minor") being permitted to participate in any way in the EVENT(S) and/or being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA(S) (defined to be any area which requires special authorization, credentials or permission to enter or any area to which admission by the general public is restricted or prohibited), I agree:

1. I know the nature of the EVENT(S) and the Minor's experience and capabilities, and believe the Minor to be qualified to participate in the Event(s). I will inspect the premises, facilities, and equipment to be used, or with which the Minor may come in contact.
